SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Dawn Stemple, from the Regional Minister of the Christian Church, Disciples of Christ. Welcome, Pastor.

PASTOR STEMPEL: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Roll call, would senators please check in.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Willhoft.

SENATOR WILLHOFT: Mr. Speaker, I move that the rules as now in our possession be adopted for today only, Wednesday, January 14, 1998.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. Any debate? All those in favor of adopting the temporary rules say aye. Those opposed. They are adopted. Mr. Clerk, any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Just one item, LR 305 is ready for your signature, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: While the Legislature is capable of transacting business and in session, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 305. Mr. Clerk. The next item on our agenda is the adoption of the permanent rules.

CLERK: Mr. President, yesterday's action left by Senator Will, in withdrawing the committees proposals. I have one proposal this morning, the proposal offered by Senators Brown, Bromm and Beutler. It's found on page 285 of the Legislative Journal. (Rule 7, Section 3 and Rule 7, Section 10.)
