SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (Microphone not activated immediately)...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our pastor is Christian DeLaRosa, who is the pastor at the Calvary Methodist Church, here in Lincoln. Pastor.

PASTOR DeLaROSA: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Roll call. Senators, please check in. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Just one item. Senator Janssen would like to print an amendment to LB 252. That's the only item I have this morning, Mr. President. (See page 339 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. We will have introduction of new bills as we go through this morning. Our first item on the agenda is motion to withdraw, LB 918. Senator Chambers, you are recognized to open on your motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, these bills are going to be withdrawn by me, and I want it done in an expeditious manner so that they won't be printed up, if they're not printed up already, but also in order to give others, whom the Department of Corrections may contact, the opportunity to have them redrafted and reintroduced. One does not fit that description, but that's why I'm seeking the withdrawal of these bills this morning. So I would move that LB 918 be withdrawn.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate? Seeing none, Senator Chambers to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the motion to withdraw LB 918. All those in favor vote aye, all
