SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (Microphone not activated immediately.)
...this morning our chaplain of the day is Interim Pastor Herman
Gruis, from Firth, he's with the Reformed Church. Pastor.

PASTOR GRUIS: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I now call the seventeenth day of the
Nebraska Legislature to order. Roll call, senators, please
check in.

SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Record, please.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the
Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any messages, reports, or announcement?

CLERK: Just one item, and that is a hearing notice from the
Transportation Committee, Madam President. That's all that I
have this morning. (See page 495 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay. We'll go to General File, LB 360.

CLERK: (LB) 360, a bill that's on General File, originally
introduced by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) The bill was
introduced on January 15 of last year, at that time referred to
the Government Committee for public hearing, advanced to General
File. It was discussed on the floor, this year, on January 28,
at that time Senator Brashear offered an amendment, AM1514.
Senator Schimek had an amendment to that, that was adopted.
Senator Brashear, your amendment, 1514, is pending, Senator.
