SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our chaplain is our Chaplain Coordinator, Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I call the twenty-first day of the Legislature to order. Senators, please check in, roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Transportation Committee, Chaired by Senator Bromm, reports (LB) 1143 and (LB) 1279 to General File; and LB 1030 to General File with committee amendments attached. Those reports signed by Senator Bromm as Chair. And LR 322 is ready for your signature, Mr. President. That's all that I have. (See page 559 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Before moving on to this morning's General File, while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 322. We next move to General File. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 777, introduced by Senator Jensen and others. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January of last year, has been on the floor and discussed on January 30, February 3, February 4, a series of amendments have been adopted to the bill. I do have additional amendments this morning, Mr. President.
