SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our chaplain for the day is Pastor Daryl Lauber, from the Bethany Christian Church, here in Lincoln. Pastor.

PASTOR LAUBER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I call the thirty-seventh day of the Nebraska Legislature to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, at this time I have no messages, reports, and/or announcements.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. First agenda item, LB 939.

CLERK: Mr. President, 939, on Final Reading. Senator Chambers would move to return the bill for specific amendment, the amendment being to strike the enacting clause.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Excuse me, Mr. Clerk. I would remind the members that we are on Final Reading, and we're required by our own rules to be in our seats, and so now, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would...

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Chambers has the first amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir.
