PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Curtis Holzworth, from the Free Evangelical Church in Grand Island, in Senator Peterson's district. Pastor Holzworth.

PASTOR HOLZWORTH: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor. I now call the forty-sixth legislative day to order. Will senators please record your presence. Record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?
