SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning and welcome to George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Father Gross from Bishop Neumann School in Wahoo, from Senator Bromm's District. Father.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. I now call to order the fifty-second day, Monday, March 30, 1998, of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, Second Session. Roll call. Will the senators please record their presence.
