SENATOR WESELY PRESIDING

SENATOR WESELY: Chair recognizes Senator Wehrbein for the prayer.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein, appreciate that. I would now like to call the fourth day of the 1998 Special Session to order. Please check in. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR WESELY: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, lobby report for this past week to be inserted in the Journal. Confirmation hearing report from General Affairs, signed by Senator Schellpeper. Enrollment and Review reports LB 2 and LB 1 to Select File, both having Enrollment and Review amendments.
