SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber, the fifty-fifth day. Our chaplain this morning is Harland Johnson. Harland.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senators, roll call. We have 15 junior and senior high Alliance High School students, from Senator Bob Wickersham's district, and there are four sponsors along with them. Would you please welcome them to the George W. Norris Chambers. Thank you very much for coming. That's a long drive for you. Record, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President. And I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no messages, reports, or announcements at this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We are now ready for General File, senator priority bills. We will now take up LB 822. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 822 was discussed yesterday by the Legislature. It's a bill originally introduced by the Natural Resources Committee. (Read title.) Senator Schrock opened on the bill, explained the committee amendments. There were a couple of amendments offered to the committee amendments. This morning I have further amendments to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, you're recognized to give a brief overview of the bill and the discussion that took place yesterday.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, (LB) 822 is a bill that would limit expansion on current livestock facilities in class...cold A...type A streams, cold water type A streams, I think I've got that right. And it would
