SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our chaplain for the day is Pastor Daryl Lauber. He's from the Bethany Christian Church, here in Lincoln, from Senator Price's district. Pastor.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I call the eighty-sixth day of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections?

CLERK: (Read corrections, Legislative Journal page 2343.) That's the only item I have this morning. Sorry about that, Senator Raikes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, bills read on Final Reading, last evening, were presented to the Governor at 5:35, last night (re: LB 32, LB 32A, LB 594, and LB 594A). Lobby Report for this week, Mr. President, to be inserted in the Journal. And I've received a report from the Ethanol Board, required by statute.
