SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber, the twenty-ninth day. Our minister this morning, our pastor, is Donald Morton and his wife Carol, United Methodist Church, from Culbertson, Nebraska. This is in Senator Baker's district. Would you please rise. Pastor.

PASTOR MORTON: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: I thank you, Pastor Morton. We'll call the twenty-ninth day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature's Session to order. Senators, please record your presence.

Your Committee on Banking reports LB 1197 to General File with amendments, and LB 1207, LB 1250, LB 1437 as indefinitely postponed.
