SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Charles Larsen of the Country Bible Church at Blair, Nebraska, and he's from Senator Connealy's district. Pastor.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Members, before we begin debate today, you will see, under General File in all of the areas today, a rule that talks about if amendments are adopted, other than a Standing Committee amendment, and if it adds new subject matter that the bill will not be scheduled for Select File.
