SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber, the seventy-second day. Our chaplain today is Pastor Dan Zitterkopf from Bayard Assembly of God Church, Bayard, Nebraska, Senator Erdman's district, accompanied by his wife, Elizabeth, and children, Jordan, Samuel, Abigail, and Isaac.
