SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning, our chaplain for the day is Senator Lowen Kruse. Senator.

SENATOR KRUSE: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Lowen. I call the forty-eighth day of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature to order. Senators, please record your presence, roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, would you report the corrections one at a time, please?

CLERK: Mr. President, I'm pleased to present I have no corrections this morning.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have the report of registered lobbyists for this week, and received reports from the Humanities Council and the Department of Roads. Those are the only items I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1233-1234.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (Doctor of the day introduced.) We next move to General File, 2002 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk, LB 791.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 791, a bill by Senator Janssen relating to the State Lottery Act. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17, of last year, at that time referred to the General Affairs Committee. The bill was reported to the General File. It was discussed on the floor last February, Mr. President, at that time failed to advance. I have an amendment to the bill pending this morning from Senator Janssen, Mr. President.
