PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fifth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, First Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Vrtiska. Please rise.

SENATOR VRTISKA: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. I call the fifth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, First Special Session to order. Please record your presence, roll call. Record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Mr. Clerk, corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President. (Corrections, Legislative Journal page 55.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Mr. Clerk, messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Health and Human Services reports LB 10 to General File, LB 11 to General File, LB 8 as indefinitely postponed. I have a confirmation hearing notice from the General Affairs Committee signed by Senator Janssen, as Chair; Attorney General's Opinion to Senator Quandahl regarding LB 6, LB 7, and LB 19; and the report of registered lobbyists for this week to be inserted in the Journal, pursuant to law. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 55-64.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: We'll now proceed to General File. LB 2, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 2 on General File, was a bill introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on October 25; referred directly to General File, Mr. President.
