PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the ninth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, First Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Burling. Please rise.

SENATOR BURLING: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Burling. I call the ninth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, First Special Session to order. Senators, please record your presence, roll call. Record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Mr. Clerk, corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no corrections this morning.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Mr. Clerk, messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Just one item, Mr. President. A report of registered lobbyists, as required by law, will be filed in the Legislative Journal. That's the only item I have at this time. (Legislative Journal page 109.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Mr. Clerk, we'll move to Final Reading. Members should return to their seat in preparation for Final Reading. Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, the first vote is to dispense with the at-large reading on LB 1. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The at-large reading is suspended. Mr. Clerk, please read the title.
