PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the second day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Second Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Jones. Please rise.

SENATOR JONES: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Jones. I call the second day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Second Special Session to order. Senators, please record your presence. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Mr. Clerk, corrections for the Journal.
