SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. This morning's prayer will be offered by Senator Price.

SENATOR PRICE: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Members, please record your presence. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Do you have any messages or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have received a series of hearing notices, from the Education; Health and Human Services; Banking, Commerce and Insurance; Appropriations; General Affairs; Government, Military and Veterans Affairs; and the Revenue Committees. All of those notices signed by the respective committee chairs. Mr. President, I have a new resolution, LR 3, offered by Senator Erdman. Be laid over.
