SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fifth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Second Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Hudkins. Please rise.

SENATOR HUDKINS: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Health and Human Services reports LB 10 to General File, LB 4 to General File. That's Health and Human Services. Excuse me. Education Committee reports LB 4 to General File, with amendments; (LB 6 to General File); and LB 7 indefinitely postponed; and LB 14 indefinitely postponed. Appropriations Committee reports LB 3 to General File, LB 12 to General File. And Education Committee reports LB 5 to General File, with amendments; and LB 41 to General File, with amendments. Those reports all signed by their respective Standing Committee chairs. Mr. President, I have a hearing notice from the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee for confirmation hearing. I have received two confirmation reports, one from the Education Committee, a second from Health and Human Services.
