SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for today is Senator Byars. Please rise.

SENATOR BYARS: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Byars. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: (Read corrections, Legislative Journal page 65.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Mr. Clerk, do you have any messages, reports, or announcements for the body?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Your Committee on Transportation reports LB 18 to General File; LB 15, LB 16, and LB 30 as indefinitely postponed. Those reports signed by Senator Jones as acting chair.
