SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the tenth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Second Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Elaine Stuhr. Please rise.

SENATOR STUHR: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President. (Corrections, Legislative Journal page 125.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Any messages, or announcements?

CLERK: Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 8 to Select File with Enrollment and Review amendments attached. Enrollment and Review also reports LB 6, LB 9, LB 11, LB 13, LB 18, LB 22, LB 25, LB 41, LB 48, and LB 49 as correctly engrossed. That's all I have at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you. Next item?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1, a bill originally introduced by the Speaker and Senator Wehrbein at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was discussed on August 8, Mr. President. At that time, the committee amendments were offered. There was a division requested. The committee amendments were divided into three components. The first component was dealt with. The second component is now pending, FA1119, and I do have amendments to FA1119, Mr. President. (FA1119, Legislative Journal page 107.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Wehrbein, without
