SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the twelfth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Second Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Don Preister. Please rise.
