SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the thirteenth and last day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature's Second Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Schrock. Please rise.

SENATOR SCHROCK: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senators, please record your presence. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, at this time I have neither messages, reports, nor announcements.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll move to Final Reading. Members, please return to your seats in preparation for Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, the first bill is LB 4E.

CLERK: (Read LB 4 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. Legislative Journal pages 161-162.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 4E has passed. We will now proceed to LB 5.
