PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the second day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Third Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Price. Please rise.
