SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the seventh day of the Special Session. Our chaplain for today is Senator Vrtiska. Please rise.

SENATOR VRTISKA: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. I call the second day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Third Special...the seventh day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, Third Special Session to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call.
