PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the seventeenth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain for today is Pastor Tom Peyton of the Evangelical Free Church of Ord, Nebraska. He is Senator Erdman's guest. Please rise.
