SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the twenty-fourth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain this morning is Pastor Joe Culpepper, Southview Christian Church, Lincoln, Senator Beutler's district. We would welcome him to say the prayer this morning. Please rise.

PASTOR CULPEPPER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Pastor Culpepper. Members, please record your presence. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Do you have any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, communication from the Speaker regarding the referral of LR 32 to Reference Committee for a referral to standing committee for public hearing.
