SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain this morning is Pastor Roger Sloan from the Church of Christ in Cozad, and that is mine, Senator Cudaback's, district. Pastor.
