PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fortieth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain is Reverend Doctor Fobert Rademacher of Kennard, pastor of two churches, Immanuel Lutheran of Orum and Emmaus Lutheran of Kennard, and from Senator Matt Connealy's district and Senator Dwite Pedersen's district. Please rise.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Reverend Doctor Robert Rademacher. I call the fortieth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

Education Committee, chaired by Senator Raikes, reports LB 513 to General File.
