PRESIDENT HEINEMAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the sixty-seventh day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain for today is Pastor Edward Price, All Nations Church of the Lord Jesus Christ here in Lincoln. He's a guest of Senator Dwite Pedersen. Please rise.

PASTOR PRICE: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Pastor Price. I call the sixty-seventh day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Corrections for the Journal.

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Messages, reports, or announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they have examined LB 197 and find the same correctly engrossed; LB 267, LB 667A, all of those reported correctly engrossed. Those are the only items I have this morning, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal page 1361.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you. We will now proceed to the first item on the agenda. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 759, a bill introduced by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) The bill was discussed yesterday, Mr. President. The committee amendments were offered. There was a division of the committee amendments. When the Legislature recessed or adjourned for the day, the Legislature was considering the first component of the committee amendments, FA1326.
