SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator Burling. Senator Burling.

SENATOR BURLING: Prayer offered.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Burling, for doing that for us. We appreciate it. I call the seventy-fourth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have neither messages, reports, nor announcements at this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. We now go to, as the agenda states, Select File, 2003 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 754 on Select File. The Enrollment and Review amendments have been considered and adopted. Senator Bromm had an amendment, AM1577, that was considered and adopted. I do have an additional amendment at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Bromm, why don't you give us a quick review of where we stand with LB 754.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. When we left on Thursday, we had just adopted an amendment which we had been debating. The amendment provided some additional, I think, guidelines and clarity to the portion of the bill that applies to the issuance of special use or exceptions, permits, for
