SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator Jones. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones, for doing that for us. We appreciate it. I call the sixth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, at this time I have neither messages, reports, nor announcements to report.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now go to General File. Mr. Clerk, first agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 4CA, introduced by Senator Schrock, and discussed yesterday by the Legislature. It's a constitutional amendment to Article XV, by adding a new Section 25. The resolution was introduced in January of last year, referred to Natural Resources, advanced to General File. When the Legislature adjourned for the day, Senator Chambers had pending FA1169. (Legislative Journal page 643, First Session, 2003.)
