SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator Janssen. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen, for doing that for us. We appreciate it. I call the twenty-first day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.
