SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day is Pastor William Bertrand, Saint Paul's Lutheran Church, and Immanuel Lutheran Church in Wakefield, and Saint Paul's is in Concord, Nebraska, and it's Senator Engel's district. Pastor Bertrand.
