SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: (Recorder malfunction)...Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day is Reverend Flores, Lutheran Church, School, Omaha Nebraska, Senator Preister's district. Reverend.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you very much, Reverend Flores, for being with us. We appreciate you being here. I call the fifty-first day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in.
