SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Good morning.      Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber.      Our chaplain of the day is Father Lloyd Gnirk, from St. Pius X Catholic Church, Omaha, Nebraska. That's Senator Bourne's district.      Father.

FATHER GNIRK:      (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:      We thank you, Father Gnirk, for being with us.      We appreciate it.      Call the fifty-third day, Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session, to order.      Senators, please check in.      Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Do you have any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK:      I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK:      Mr. President, report of registered lobbyists for this week, to be inserted in the Journal.      On file in the Clerk's Office is a report from the Crime Commission.      And I've received a communication from the Douglas County Board of Commissioners.      That's all that I have, Mr. President.      (Legislative Journal pages 1449-1450.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Okay.      Thank you, Mr. Clerk.      We now go to Select File, budget and budget-related bills.      Mr. Clerk, first bill.

CLERK:      Mr. President, LB 1090, on Select File, has been discussed both on March 31 and April 1.      At this time, Mr. President, what I have pending is an amendment from Senator Janssen.      He had offered an AM, specifically AM3512.      That amendment was divided.      Senator Janssen, the Legislature disposed of FA1654.      I now have pending, Senator, FA1655.
