SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day is Pastor Carl Lilienkamp, from Grace Lutheran Church, Wayne, Nebraska, Senator Engel's district. Pastor.

PASTOR LILIENKAMP: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Pastor Lilienkamp comes from the 17th District. Thank you very much for being with us this morning. I call the thirtieth day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. Record please, Mr. Clerk.
