SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator Heidemann. Senator Heidemann.

SENATOR HEIDEMANN: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Heidemann. Appreciate that. I call the sixty-ninth day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are there any corrections for the journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Your Committee on Judiciary, chaired by Senator Bourne, reports LB 348 to General File with amendments attached. And Mr. President, I have a series of amendments to be printed to LB 57 by Senator Chambers. That's all that I have. (Legislative Journal pages 1315-1316.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We now go to General File, 2005 Senator priority bills, the McDonald division. Mr. Clerk, LB 117.

CLERK: LB 117, Mr. President, a bill by Senator Bourne, introduced at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was discussed yesterday, Mr. President. Committee amendments were offered by Senator Bourne, as Chair of the Judiciary Committee. Pursuant to a request for a division of the question, the committee amendments were divided into seven components. The first committee amendment is FA188, Mr. President. That consists...well, you have a summary sheet on your desk that describes what FA188 is. And that's where we are, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal page 1301.)
