PRESIDENT SHEEHY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT SHEEHY: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day is Pastor Doug Griger of the United Methodist Church from Alliance, Nebraska, Senator Louden's district. Would you all please rise.

PASTOR GRIGER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT SHEEHY: Thank you, Pastor Griger. We will now call the sixth day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Would all senators please check in. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT SHEEHY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Do you have any corrections, messages, reports, or announcements at your desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, correction. (Read corrections, Legislative Journal page 277.) That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT SHEEHY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. (Doctor of the day introduced.) Currently, there are no new bills for introduction, so we will move to General File. First item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 454, introduced by Senator Combs. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13, 2005, at that time referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File with Judiciary Committee amendments attached. I do have amendments pending to the bill, Mr. President. The bill was discussed briefly last year. (AM0810, Legislative Journal page 1076, First Session, 2005.)
