SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day is Pastor Frank Armstrong, First Baptist Church, Norfolk; Senator Flood's district, District 19. Pastor, please.

PASTOR ARMSTRONG: (Prayer offered.)

I have a report of registered lobbyists to be on file in the Clerk's Office, Mr. President, and I have received reports from the Energy Office and the Department of Roads. Both will be available for member review. An announcement, Mr. President: The Agriculture Committee will have an Executive Session next Tuesday, February 21; next Tuesday, February 21, in Room 2102.
