SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator Combs from the 32nd District. Senator, please.

SENATOR COMBS: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Combs, for doing that for us. We appreciate it. I call the fifty-third day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 925, LB 1256, LB 1006, LB 239, LB 489, and LB 845 to Select File, some of which have Enrollment and Review amendments attached. Confirmation hearing report from Retirement Systems, and hearing notices from Health and Human Services, and from the Agriculture Committee. That's all that I have, Mr. President. SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. I will try to make the agenda item a little more clearly. Please note that, as indicated on the agenda, at 11:45 today we will interrupt the item we are debating to advance all Select File bills listed on today's agenda that have no amendments or only an E & R amendment. We will then continue working our way through the agenda, beginning with the item that we left off at 11:45. (Doctor of the day introduced.) We will now go to General File, appropriations bill. Mr. Clerk, please, LB 1256A.
