SENATOR CUDABACK:    Good morning.    Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain this morning is Senator Kruse, from the 13th District. Senator Kruse.

SENATOR KRUSE:    (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:    Thank you, Senator Kruse. We appreciate you doing that for us. I call the thirteenth day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please check in.

CLERK:    I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK:    I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    Messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK:    Mr. President, the...I have a rereferral of LB 584, from the Judiciary to the Agriculture Committee; as well as a referral of a gubernatorial appointee. Hearing notices from Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee; Business and Labor Committee; Transportation, Telecommunications Committee; Education Committee; and the Agriculture Committee; those all signed by their respective chairs. Your Committee on Revenue, chaired by Senator Landis, reports LB 28 and LB 383 to General File; LB 216, LB 334 to General File with amendments; and LB 45 and LB 46 indefinitely postponed; those reports signed by Senator Landis. New resolutions. LR 30, by Senator Erdman. That will be laid over, Mr. President. LR 31, by Senator Flood; and LR 32, by Senator Flood.
